Justice For Orphans (JFO) and its CarePortal network are transforming lives in the Schenectady School District, where 81% of students face economic hardships. A recent video showcases how these initiatives meet essential needs, foster relationships, and build brighter futures.

Supporting Families in Need

Through JFO's leadership, CarePortal bridges between churches, community members, and schools, enabling swift responses to specific needs. It has helped establish food pantries in all 17 district schools and provided essentials like beds, lice kits, and winter coats. These efforts create better learning environments and strengthen trust between schools and families.

Preventing Crisis

A key strength of this collaboration is intervening before families fall into crisis. Working with teachers and volunteers who see children daily, CarePortal identifies and meets needs early, often preventing crises. JFO's CarePortal network not only provides resources but also fosters community and belonging. Pastor Dennis Graham Parker noted, "CarePortal provides a bridge to the people we desperately want to serve."

Parenthood is rarely a predictable path, and for one foster and adoptive mother, it began with a call about a six-month-old baby named Hope. That moment sparked a journey filled with love, challenges, and resilience. Her story, now shared in a powerful video, reveals the vital role of JFO in supporting families navigating foster care and adoption.

A Growing Family, A Journey of Discovery

This mother and her husband started their foster journey with a desire to build a family. After completing the MAPS class, they welcomed Hope and later, two more siblings, Nathan and Rose. Though their home filled with love, challenges emerged—especially with Nathan, whose symptoms went beyond ADHD. Attending an FASD (Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder) training by JFO became a turning point. Hearing advocate Sandra Flach outline FASD symptoms brought clarity, helping this mother understand Nathan's needs and connect with essential resources.



Strength Through Loss and Community

When Sue's husband passed away suddenly, she faced parenthood alone. Amid grief, JFO became a lifeline, providing support groups, education, and connections to others on similar paths. Resources like the Adoption and Foster Care Journey Podcast offered encouragement and practical advice, reminding her she wasn't alone.

Empowered by Support

JFO's programs transformed Sue's journey from specialized FASD training to community-building support. The organization equipped her to advocate for her children and navigate challenges with strength. Her story exemplifies the power of education, support, and community in fostering resilience.
